Bonnie Blair The most decorated U.S. winter Olympian of all-time with five gold medals. Bonnie won an unprecedented three straight Olympic gold medals in the 500 meters (1988, 1992, 1994). Daryl "Moose" Johnston One of the NFL's premier blocking fullbacks during an 11-year career with the Cowboys. He became a full-time starter in 1991 and was a key member of the Cowboys' three Super Bowl winning teams (1993, 1994 and 1996). A two-time Pro Bowl selection (1993 and 1994), at one point he played in 149 consecutive games. Currently an analyst an NFL analyst on FOX. Fee is \$16,500 + 1st class travel from Dallas



Isiah Thomas President of Basketball Operations for the New York Knicks. Thomas was a 12-time All Star point guard for the Detroit Pistons and was elected to Basketball Hall of Fame in 2000. Ben Howland Head coach of UCLA basketball team. Led UCLA to the National Championship game in 2006, in just his third year with UCLA. Mike Brey Head coach of Notre Dame basketball team. Since taking over head coaching position in 2000, Brey has led Notre Dame to 1 Big East title, 3 NCAA tournament appearances, and a Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2003. Fee is \$8,250 plus 1st class travel from South Bend.



Mick Cronin Named Head Coach of University of Cincinnati basketball team in 2006. In previous three seasons at Murray State, Cronin compiled a 69-23 record, including 2 NCAA tournament appearances. Fee is \$6,250 plus 1st class travel from Cincinnati.



Kerri Strug Gold medal winner in gymnastics at 1996 Olympics in Atlanta. Strug led the U.S. team to gold medal by overcoming injury and landing her vault on a severely sprained ankle. Strug's courageous performance on vault led to her winning the Olympic Spirit Award, which was also presented to Carl Lewis at the 1996 Olympic Games. Fee is \$8,250 plus 1st class travel from Washington, D.C.



Allison Baver Two-time Olympic Short Track Speedskater. Finished third in overall World Cup Rankings in 2005. Fee is \$6,250 + 1st class travel from Colorado Springs

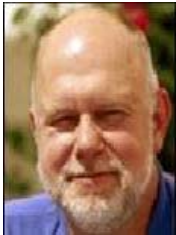
